



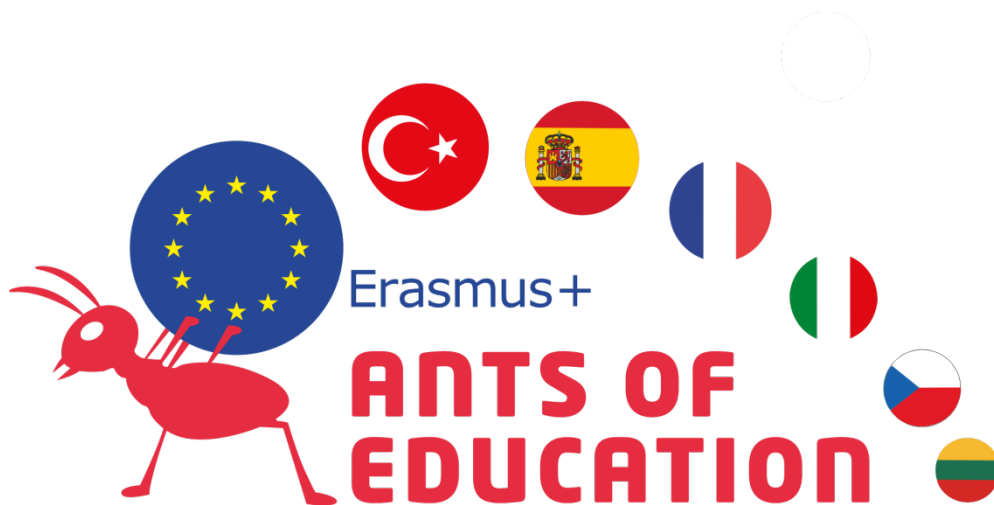

### ANTS OF EDUCATION - PROJECT ONLINE MEETING

25 – 27 MAY 2020



#### MEETING REPORT



The last meeting in Kaunas, Lithuania was scheduled for week from 12<sup>th</sup> May 2020 to 19<sup>th</sup> May 2020. However, the pandemic situation of Corona virus broke out worldwide in March 2020. Therefore, the school coordinators had videoconference 24<sup>th</sup> April 2020 to solve the last project meeting and prolonging of the project. During May, there were closed boards in Europe. School management from Lithuania, Turkey and France decided not to prolong the project. That's why all partners agreed the last meeting online way instead exchange meeting.

Lithuanian coordinator Neringa Lenciauskaite prepared online program for all five days and all partners agreed with online meeting for three days from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> May 2020. Other days were assigned for preparing and performing the tasks. The program included tasks and goals of exchange meeting what are possible to make online way. During the online meeting all partners have finished all the project outputs.

The 6<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Erasmus+ project “Ants of Education” which was held online was divided in 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

The organizer of the 6<sup>th</sup> meeting was the Lithuanian school “Kauno buitiniu paslaugu ir verslo mokykla,,.

The Italian partner from the “Istituto d'Istruzione Superiore 'Margherita Hack” was composed of the teacher Ms Rosaria Corica and the students Miss Caterina Salvatori, Miss Katiuscia Selis and Mr Paolo Leca.

The Spanish partner from the “Centro San Viator” was composed of the teachers Ms Ane Ruiloba Perez and Ms Patricia Pinto Barrientos and the students Miss Markel Alda Rabadan, Miss Markel de Miguel Sanchez and Miss Iker de la Cuesta Velasquez.

The Lithuanian partner from the “Kauno buitiniu paslaugu ir verslo mokykla” was composed of the teacher Ms Neringa Lenciauskaite and the students Miss Ina Romanova and Miss Jeva Vilkauskaite.

The French partner from the “Kauno buitiniu paslaugu ir verslo mokykla” was composed of the teacher Ms Sarah El Bouh and students Miss Chemali Mayssa, Miss Diaw Yelene, Miss Collin Anna and Miss Lucia Fau.

The Turkish partner from “Özel Güney Fen Bilimleri Anadolu Lisesi” was composed of the teacher Mr. Tuncay Savtak and the students Miss Sude AŞKIN, Miss Sude AKINCI, Miss Fatma Sıla YILMAZ, Mr Ahmet Mert MUTLU, Miss Sude AKINCI, Mr Meriç EREL, Mr Barkın SABAH, Mr Berker ÇETİNKAYA and Miss Nisa Begüm ALADAĞ.

The Czech partner from “Střední odborná škola ochrany osob a majetku s.r.o.” was composed of the teachers Ms Alexandra Florková and Mr Michal Florek and the students Miss Anička Burkotová, Mr Alexandr Wiglasz, Mr David Vosáhlo and Miss Sofia Issiridirová.

The online meeting was led by main coordinator Michal Florek and Lithuanian coordinator Neringa Lenčiauskaitė. On 25<sup>th</sup> May, all students from partner countries presented their schools, countries and shared presentations and videos to each other. Lithuanian student Ina Romanova introduced Lithuanian school and country. All participants watched virtual visiting in Kaunas and Lithuanian coordinator introduced program Erasmus+, our project and Lithuanian education system.

26<sup>th</sup> May students presented their presentations on the topic „Famous statesmen“, and they presented their national cuisine. Next part of the online meeting was presentation the results of the survey. Lithuanian coordinator presented the results of the survey on „Effective communication, European Citizenship“.

The last online day 27<sup>th</sup> May all participants attended seminar with expert Michael Agyeman on the main topic „Effective communication, European Citizenship“. After workshop Lithuanian coordinator had

prepared discussion hour with students about movie „Three Idiots“. All students discussed the watched movie.

Other days all partners worked on Multilingual Dictionary and Italian coordinator finished it and shared it with partners. Because of online way of the meeting, Project Garden couldn't be organized, that's why Lithuanian coordinator created a project garden on behalf of all partners with the seeds which all partners sent to Lithuania.

The partners also agreed on the following:

- Each partner school will make the dissemination of the last project meeting and it is recommended to publish their results of work on their school web pages or school facebook pages, in the local media etc. and will send the outputs both to the coordinator and the other responsible teachers so that they could upload them into the project webpage, project facebook page, etwinning page etc.
- All participating schools will send their newsletters by 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020 to the Turkish school. Maximum pages of each newsletter will be 4 pages per school. The participating schools should use word (Times New Roman-12) format and picasa for their photos and not more than 1 MB (1000 KB).
- The French school will keep maintaining the project eTwinning pages so that the visitors could see the results of our work. All partners will help to run this page.
- The Czech school will upload the results of the work (presentations, surveys etc.) on the website.
- The Lithuanian school will maintain the Facebook page and hold Skype/eTwinning conference. The exact date for Skype/eTwinning conference was agreed to be at 14:00 pm CET on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2020.
- The Spanish school will work out the brochures, photo and video-presentation (a DVD; "Memorials of the project / Products exhibition" for each partner) from the online meeting.
- All schools will continually carry on with local activities of the project according to the tasks.
- All schools will evaluate the budget of their schools and check the budget matters.

All the participants of the “Ants of Education” project appreciate the effort, the work of the Lithuanian organizers of the online meeting. All the participants find the activities very interesting and agree that they have learned a lot during the meeting. All the planned tasks and activities were fully accomplished.

Because of the global pandemic situation it was the last meeting in the project.
