ANTS OF EDUCATION - PROJECT MEETING ANTALYA - 14 / 19, NOVEMBER, 2018



MEETING REPORT



The 1st mobility of the Erasmus+ project “Ants of Education” was held between 14th and 19th November 2018 in Antalya, Turkey.

The organizer of the 1st mobility was the Turkish school “Özel Güney Fen Bilimleri Anadolu Lisesi”

The Czech delegation from “Střední odborná škola ochrany osob a majetku, s.r.o. (SOSOOM)” in Karviná arrived in Antalya on 13th November and departed on 20th November 2018. The delegation was composed of the SOSOOM headmaster Ms Slavka Krystová Florková, the project coordinator Mr Emil Horký, the teacher Ms Alexandra Florková, and the students Ms Veronika Menaříková, Ms Petra Minaříková, Ms Sofia Issiridirová, and Ms Anna Burkotová.

The Lithuanian delegation from the “Kauno buitiniu paslaugu ir verslo mokykla”, arrived in Antalya on 13th November and departed on 20th November 2018. The delegation was composed of Ms Neringa Lenciauskaite and Ms Ilona Urboniene, and the students Ms Nidem Palinauskaite, Ms Ruta Kirgetovaite.

The Italian delegation from the “Istituto d'Istruzione Superiore 'Margherita Hack””, arrived in Antalya on 13th November and departed on 20th November 2018. The delegation was composed of Ms Rosaria

Corica and Ms Valeria Iacono and the students Ms Giulia Cantini, Ms Margherita Rossi, Mr Simone Colangeli.

The Spanish delegation from the “Centro San Viator”, arrived in Antalya on 14th November and departed on 20th November 2018. The delegation was composed of Ms Ane Ruiloba Perez and Mr Pablo Dias and the students Ms Haizea Ajenjo Sedano, Mr Nicolas Miguel Alvarez, Mr Axel Sanchez Alonso.

The French delegation from the “Lycee Maurice Genevoix”, arrived in Antalya on 13th November and departed on 20th November 2018. The delegation was composed of Ms Amina Chikar and Ms Yasmine Bellagha and the students Ms Bellmonte Vittoria, Ms Bellil Oussaima, Ms Pouvesle Romane, Ms De Piretti Diane, Mr Delcenserie Calvin, Mr Pierre Ulysse.

On Tuesday 13th and early Wednesday 14th morning, November 2018, all the participants were welcomed by the host teachers at the airport and then transferred to the hotel, where the teachers had their rooms booked and where the host families met their guest students. On the departure day, the participating teams were also transferred to the airport by the host teachers and the host families.

On Wednesday 14th November 2018, all the participants gathered at school for the opening ceremony. After the ceremony the presentations of the Turkish education system and the host school were presented. Later on the participating schools presented their own countries, towns and schools. The host school presented Erasmus+ programme and the project. After the lunch at school, the project logo competition was held and the project logo from the Turkish school was chosen by the participants. Then, all mobilities, tasks, activities, disseminations, deadlines were checked and set by the present teachers. Students, in the meantime attended lessons with the Turkish students. The “Project Garden” was organized. In the evening a “Welcome Dinner” was held for the teachers and the students spent their evening with their host families.

On Thursday 15th November 2018 the presentation of the results of the surveys on “Entrepreneurship” was introduced to all the participants by individual countries. After the survey result presentations there was organized Cultural hour: “History of Partner Countries, PART-1, Turkey, the Czech Republic, France”. In the cultural hour the above mentioned teams presented their important historical periods. After lunch at school, all the participants were met by the Mayor and the local authorities at the city hall. The meeting with the Mayor and the local authorities was followed by a visit to Sandland/Antalya legends, a walking tour, sightseeing and shopping in the city centre.

On Friday 16th November the teachers and students attended lessons with Turkish students. The second part of Cultural hour: “History of Partner Countries” was held in which Spain, Italy, Lithuania presented their most important historical periods. Later on, there was a workshop on “Europass”. After the lunch at school, all the participants joined the seminar on “Entrepreneurship” given in English by experts at ATSO / Antalya Chamber of Commerce and Industry. After this programme, the “National Cuisine Day” took place in the school canteen. During this event all the participants had an opportunity to taste the partners’ typical dishes served in their countries.

On Saturday 17th November, the workshop on writing a CV was organized. After the workshop, the participants watched the film “The Class” and after the film they discussed the plot and other related issues. Later, all the participants visited Antalya museum and a mosque where they learned about the history and religion of the city and the region. Then, they had their lunch in the city center and went sightseeing.

On Sunday 18th, due to the bad weather conditions, the whole day trip was cancelled and the workshop “History of Civilization” was postponed to Monday 19th. This day was set as the free day for all so that

they could learn about the city, its history and culture of the host country. Some students had the traditional Turkish breakfast together with other host students so that they could learn about the culture, the way of life and the traditions of Turkey, some students spent the day with their host families, while some teachers visited the most important places of interest in Antalya.

On Monday 19th, the workshop on “Multilingual Dictionary” was organized in which students worked together to prepare the most frequent and useful phrases in their national languages and English. The Dictionary workshop was followed by the Cultural Hour activity on “History of Civilization”. Then the host school explained how to organize the “Newsletters”. After the lunch at school, the teachers discussed the dissemination of the project meeting, evaluation / progress check at the teachers’ meeting while the students were attending the lessons. The teachers agreed on the planned activities and tasks to be done and the methods to be used between the meetings in the Czech Republic and Italy.

In the late afternoon, all the participants were given their certificates of attendance and the 1nd mobility was officially completed.

On Tuesday 20th November all the participants departed from the Antalya airport.

During the 1st mobility the teachers agreed on the tasks to be done for the 2nd exchange in the Czech Republic which will be held between 6th March (arrival) and 13th March 2019 (departure).

The delegations also agreed on the following:


- Each partner school will make the dissemination of the 1st project meeting and it is recommended to publish their results of work on their school web pages or school facebook pages, in the local media etc. and will send the outputs both to the coordinator and the other responsible teaches so that they could upload them into the project webpage, project facebook page, etwinning page etc.
- Each country will prepare some national dishes that will be presented at the National Cuisine Day in the school in the Czech Republic.
- Each country will prepare a short presentation of their country, town and school to be presented during the mobility in the Czech Republic. (5 min. maximum).
- Each country will bring some seeds / plants to help to organize the Project Garden in the Czech Republic.
- The Czech team will prepare a survey on “Gender issues, discrimination, human rights, and multilingualism” and will send it to the partner schools by the end of December. Each school will then carry out the survey with 30-50 students and send the results to the host school by the end of January.
- The Turkish school will publish the evaluation form by 26th November and will collect the answers by 12th December. Then the host Turkish school will work out the evaluation results by 26th December. Only the participating students and teachers will take part in this evaluation activity. Then, the host Turkish school will send the results to the coordinator so that they could share them with the responsible teacher to be published on twinspace (eTwinning) before the 2nd mobility.
- All participating schools will send their newsletters by Dec. 17th to the Turkish school. Maximum pages of each newsletter will be 4 pages per school. The participating schools should use word (Times New Roman-12) format and picasa for their photos.
- The French school will open new pages on eTwinning so that the visitors could see the results of our work. All partners will help to run this page.

- The participating schools are asked to send their name lists as soon as they know the names of participants (together with ages, genders and email addresses). Then, the Czech school will send the other partners the programme of the 2nd mobility and the host families' contacts by 20th February.
- The Czech school will upload the results of the work (presentations, surveys etc.) on the website.
- The Italian school will organize the Europass and multilingual dictionary. For the Europass, each partner school will fill in their Europasses on their own and bring to the 2nd meeting in the Czech Republic so that the host school could sign them at the end of the project meeting.
- The Lithuanian school will organize the Facebook page and a Skype conference, the exact date will be agreed by the school coordinators through email communication.
- The Spanish school will work out the brochures, photo and video-presentation (a DVD; "Memorials of the project / Products exhibition" for each partner) from the meeting in Turkey to be presented at the meeting in the Czech Republic.
- The dates of the third meeting in Italy is suggested for the first week of May (a subject of further agreement among the partners).
- After the third meeting, the coordinator of the project will send to the leaders a blank availability chart for the school year 2019 / 2020 to be filled in. After collecting the responses, the coordinator will suggest the dates for the meetings in France, Spain and Lithuania.
- All schools will continually carry on with local activities of the project according to the tasks.
- All schools will evaluate the budget of the 1st project in their schools and check the budget matters.


All the participants of the "Ants of Education" project appreciate the effort, the work and the warm hospitality of the Turkish organizers of the 1st mobility. All the participants find the activities very interesting and agree that they have learned a lot during the meeting. All the planned tasks and activities were fully accomplished.

The next meeting is going to be held in Karviná, the Czech Republic between 6th and 13th March 2019.
