ANTS OF EDUCATION - PROJECT MEETING KARVINÁ

7 – 12 MARCH 2019



MEETING REPORT



The 2nd mobility of the Erasmus+ project “Ants of Education” was held between 7th and 12th March 2019 in Karviná, Czech Republic.

The organizer of the 2nd mobility was the Czech school “Střední odborná škola ochrany osob a majetku s.r.o.”.

The Italian delegation from the “Istituto d'Istruzione Superiore 'Margherita Hack’”, arrived in Karviná on 6th March and departed on 13th March 2019. The delegation was composed of Ms Rosaria Corica and Ms Cristina Portoghese and the students Mr Flavio Mazzilli, Mr Matteo Castagnoli, Mr Matteo Fabrini, and Mr Mattia Di Filippo.

The Spanish delegation from the “Centro San Viator”, arrived in Karviná on 6th March and departed on 13th March 2019. The delegation was composed of Ms Ane Ruiloba Perez and Ms Patricia Pinto Barrientos and the students Mr Andoni Tablado Ranero, Mr Josu Parra Cuezva, Mr Xabier Arjona Sobrino.

The Lithuanian delegation from the “Kauno buitiniu paslaugu ir verslo mokykla”, arrived in Karviná on 6th March and departed on 13th March 2019. The delegation was composed of Ms Neringa Lenciauskaite and Ms Dalia Vasiliauskiene, and the students Ms Gabrielė Bajerčiūtė, Ms Malvina Palaitytė, and Ms Martyna Norkevičiūtė.

The French delegation from the “Lycee Maurice Genevoix”, arrived in Karviná on 6th March and departed on 13th March 2019. The delegation was composed of Ms Fatima Megdad and Ms Marie Boussicaud and the students Ms Aissatou Balde, Ms Maria Chbani, Ms Maria Nour Dahlab, Ms Kenza Snoussi, Ms Zeynab Ammar El Idrissi, Mr Alexandre Pavan.

The Turkish delegation from “Özel Güney Fen Bilimleri Anadolu Lisesi” in Antalya arrived in Karviná on 6th March and departed on 13th March 2019. The delegation was composed of Mr Tuncay Savtak, Mr Fethi Erel and the students Ms Deniz Yildirim, Ms Fatma Sezgin, Mr Emirkan Yeşildağ, and Mr Meriç Çapar.

On Wednesday 6th March 2019, all the participants were welcomed by the host teachers at the hotel and at the railway station. The Italian, the Spanish, and the Lithuanian teams came by bus to the hotel, where the host families met their guest pupils and where the teachers had their rooms booked. The Turkish and the French teams arrived at the railway station, where the host families collected their guest pupils. The teachers were then taken to the hotel. On the departure day, the Italian, the Spanish, and the Lithuanian teams were transferred to the airport by bus, and the Turkish and the French team were transferred to the railway station.

On Thursday 7th March 2019, all the participants gathered in front of the Fryštát Chateau. Inside the Chateau the opening ceremony was held. During the ceremony the host school presented Erasmus+ programme and the project. The ceremony was finished with a guided tour in the Chateau. After the ceremony and the guided tour all the participants moved to Střední odborná škola ochrany osob a majetku s.r.o. for lunch. In the afternoon the participating schools presented their own countries, towns and schools. The school presentations were followed by the Czech education system presentation. Later on the “Project Garden” was organized. Right after the “Project Garden”, the participants had a chance to learn in detail about the host school. A tour through the school was organized. During the tour the participants saw the equipment and the activities presented by the teachers and their pupils. These included especially the training of martial arts and the use of forensic methods. In the evening a “Welcome Dinner” was held for the teachers and the students spent their evening with their host families.

On Friday 8th March 2019 a trip to the local enterprise producing cakes was organized to present a successful business running which developed from an idea to one of the most successful ventures in the region. After lunch at school, the presentation of the results of the surveys on “Human rights, Gender issues and Multilingualism“ was introduced to all the participants by the Czech team. The survey results presentation was followed by a workshop held by an expert team concentration on the field of the human rights and gender studies. Later on the “National Cuisine Day” took place in the school canteen. During this event all the participants had an opportunity to taste the partners’ typical dishes served in their countries.

On Saturday 9th March the teachers and pupils went for a Guided tour – The leaning Church of St. Peter of Alcantara. From the church they continued to the History museum of mining in Moravian-silesian region (Underground exposition), and finally reached the Science and Technology Centre in Ostrava.

Here the programme of the day finished and the pupils with their hosts had a chance to go sight-seeing in Ostrava while the teachers were invited to the Bolt tower, a café in Ostrava.

On Sunday 10th March all the participants went for a day trip to the Memorial and Museum Auschwitz – Birkenau, where they learned about the horrible things that used to happen in the former Nazi concentration camp within the frame of the topic “Human rights”. The trip went on to the town of Krakow, where all the participants went sight-seeing.

On Monday 11th March, a discussion hour – „Good Will Hunting“ was organized. The pupils were watching 4 sections of the film and they were working in small groups on the tasks directly connected to the film. They were brainstorming, mind mapping, discussing, and making educational posters. After lunch videos on the entrepreneurship made by individual national teams were played. The videos were followed by a seminar led by an expert in the field of young and starting entrepreneurs. After the seminar all the participants left school for the company Karvinské Gofry, where they had a chance to taste the products made by the main protagonists of the Czech video. The day programme was finished by a commented sight-seeing tour in the town centre and the guided tour in the Church of the Raising of the Holy Cross.

On Tuesday 12th March, the workshop on “Multilingual Dictionary” was organized in the school ICT room. During the workshop the pupils worked together on the specific topics to complement the work which had been done within the 1st Meeting. After the lunch at school, the teachers discussed the dissemination of the project meeting, evaluation / progress check at the teachers’ meeting while the students were preparing for the ‘Farewell Dinner’. The teachers agreed on the planned activities and tasks to be done and the methods to be used between the meetings.

In the late afternoon, the ‘Farewell Dinner’ was held. Within the dinner a folklore group had their performance and finally all the participants were given their certificates of attendance and the 2nd mobility was officially completed.

On Wednesday 13th March, all the participants departed from Karviná.

During the 2nd mobility the teachers agreed on the tasks to be done for the 3rd exchange in Italy which will be held between 2nd May (arrival) and 9th May (departure). 1st week in May.

The delegations also agreed on the following:


- Each partner school will make the dissemination of the 2nd project meeting and it is recommended to publish their results of work on their school web pages or school facebook pages, in the local media etc. and will send the outputs both to the coordinator and the other responsible teaches so that they could upload them into the project webpage, project facebook page, etwinning page etc.
- Each country will prepare some national dishes that will be presented at the National Cuisine Day in the school in Italy.
- Each country will prepare a short presentation of their country, town and school to be presented during the mobility in Italy. (5 min. maximum).
- Each country will bring some seeds / plants to help to organize the Project Garden in Italy.
- The Italian team will prepare a survey on “Natural disasters” and will send it to the partner schools by 30th March 2019. Each school will then carry out the survey with 30-50 students and send the results to the host school by 15th April 2019.

- The Czech school will publish the results of the evaluation form by 30th March on the Web (eTwinning, blog, Facebook).
- All participating schools will send their newsletters by 7th April 2019 to the Turkish school. Maximum pages of each newsletter will be 4 pages per school. The participating schools should use word (Times New Roman-12) format and jpg./png. format for their photos.
- The French school will keep maintaining the project eTwinning pages so that the visitors could see the results of our work. All partners will help to run this page.
- The participating schools are asked to send their name lists as soon as they know the names of participants (together with ages, genders and email addresses). Then, the Italian school will send the other partners the programme of the 3rd mobility and the host families' contacts by 15th April 2019.
- The Czech school will upload the results of the work (presentations, surveys etc.) on the website.
- The Italian school will organize the Europass and multilingual dictionary. For the Europass, each partner school will fill in their Europasses on their own and bring to the 3rd meeting in Italy so that the host school could sign them at the end of the project meeting.
- The Lithuanian school will maintain the Facebook page and hold Skype/eTwinning conference, the exact date will be agreed by the school coordinators through email communication.
- The Spanish school will work out the brochures, photo and video-presentation (a DVD; "Memorials of the project / Products exhibition" for each partner) from the meeting in the Czech Republic to be presented at the meeting in Italy.
- The dates of the third Meeting in Italy are 2nd May (arrival) and 9th May (departure).
- After the third meeting, the coordinator of the project will send to the leaders a blank availability chart for the school year 2019 / 2020 to be filled in. After collecting the responses, the coordinator will suggest the dates for the meetings in France, Spain and Lithuania.
- All schools will continually carry on with local activities of the project according to the tasks.
- All schools will evaluate the budget of the 1st project in their schools and check the budget matters.

All the participants of the "Ants of Education" project appreciate the effort, the work and the warm hospitality of the Czech organizers of the 2nd mobility. All the participants find the activities very interesting and agree that they have learned a lot during the meeting. All the planned tasks and activities were fully accomplished.

The next meeting is going to be held in Italy between 2nd May and 9th May 2019.
