**ANTS OF EDUCATION - PROJECT MEETING SOPUERTA**  
**7 – 12 FEBRUARY 2020**



### MEETING REPORT



The 5<sup>th</sup> mobility of the Erasmus+ project “Ants of Education” was held between 7<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> February 2020 in Sopuerta, Spain.

The organizer of the 5<sup>th</sup> mobility was the Spanish school “Centro San Viator,,

The Italian delegation from the “Istituto d'Istruzione Superiore Margherita Hack,, arrived in Bilbao on 6<sup>th</sup> February and departed on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020. The delegation was composed of Ms Rosaria Corica and Mr Marco Salmistraro and the students Mr Davide Carradori, Mr Antonio Rossi and Miss Ginevra Gobbi.

The French delegation from the “Lycée Maurice Genevoix”, arrived in Bilbao on 6<sup>th</sup> February and departed on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020. The delegation was composed of Ms Sarah EL Bouh and Ms Yasmine Bellagha and the students Miss Loeva Magdeleine, Mr Etienne Lanneau, Miss Marie Brachet.

The Lithuanian delegation from the “Kauno buitiniu paslaugu ir verslo mokykla”, arrived in Bilbao on 6<sup>th</sup> February and departed on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020. The delegation was composed of Ms Vaiva Daugvilaitė and Ms Sigita Grigaliūniene, and the students Mr Markas Valėjevas, Mr Arnas Vaitkevičius, Mr Dominykas Mikšys.

The Turkish delegation from “Özel Güney Fen Bilimleri Anadolu Lisesi” in Antalya arrived in Bilbao on 6<sup>th</sup> February and departed on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020. The delegation was composed of Mr Rasit Araz, Mr Birol Orak and the students Mr Ege Arda Yücebaşar, Mr Meriç Erel and Mr Ahmet Mert Mutlu.

The Czech delegation from “Střední odborná škola ochrany osob a majetku s.r.o.” in Karviná arrived in Bilbao on 6<sup>th</sup> February and departed on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020. The delegation was composed of Ms Slavka Krystová Florková, Mr Petr Godál, Mr Michal Florek and the students Miss Anna Burkotová, Mr David Vosáhlo and Miss Sofia Issiridirová.

On Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2020, all the participants were welcomed by the Spanish coordinator of the project at the airport and were taken to the hotel and students were taken to their families. On the

departure day, all the teams were transferred to the airport by taxis and students were taken by host families.

On Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2020, the Spanish coordinator met all the teachers at the hotel and led them to school. All the partners were welcomed by the school management Alfredo Garmendia Introducing Erasmus+ and the project in the school project room. Afterwards, the Spanish team presented their school and their school system. Later all the partners were guided to see the school. After the coffee break students gave presentations on their schools. At 11:00 AM "Project garden" followed up. In the afternoon presentations by students "Similarities and differences in the education systems of the different countries of the project" took place. Later students had workshop: Creating the "perfect school". After the workshop students left the school to their host families and teachers had lunch at the school canteen. After lunch the bus was provided to Bilbao for the teachers. In the evening the visit to the Guggenheim Museum was organized for the teachers. After the Museum the teachers were invited for dinner in the restaurant "La Mary Bilbao".

On Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2020 the partners met in Bilbao in San Mames Stadium and they had a guided visit in Bilbao. After the excursion teachers and students had free time for lunch and in the afternoon they went for a "Gymkhana" in the Old Town. On Saturday evening all students and teachers had free time to enjoy sightseeing of the city.

On Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2020 students and teachers met at the Arriaga Theater in Bilbao and took a train to Gernika where they visited the Gernika Peace Museum, the air raids shelters and the street replica of Picasso's Gernika. The lunch for teachers and students was provided in the restaurant the "Hotel Boliña". In the afternoon all the participants visited the Assembly House and the Tree of Gernika. After that everyone went back to Bilbao by train.

On Monday 10<sup>th</sup> February all the partners met at school where teachers had a meeting about students stay in the host families. The meeting was followed by cultural hour and students gave presentations about "War and people". After the coffee break all the participants were taken to Getxo by school bus. In Getxo the Deputy Mayor of the town welcomed all the students and teachers. Later the organisation "Klik-in" led a workshop about "Intercultural Learning". In the afternoon the lunch for teachers and students took place in the "Betiko Lagunak" restaurant. After that the partners visited the "Bizkaia Bridge", UNESCO World Heritage site. In the evening the students went to their host families while the teachers went back to Bilbao by metro.

On Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> February the teachers were picked up from the hotel and met the students in Portugalete in the Cultural Center "Santa Clara" where they had the second part of the workshop about "Intercultural Learning" with the organisation "Klik-in". Later the reception in the town hall was given. After lunch students had free time in Portugalete while the teachers had a meeting about the next mobility in Lithuania.

On Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February the teachers and students came to school. In the project room the Spanish team presented the results of the survey "Intercultural Learning". Afterwards the teachers had a meeting about the mobility in Spain, wrote a report, discussed the tasks and the activities for the next mobility. While the students at the same time had a workshop on the Multilingual dictionary and after the coffee break the students had a discussion hour about the film "The Dead Poets Society" in ICT room. After all the activities the National Cuisine Day took place where all the countries presented their national food. In the afternoon the teachers were taken by bus to Bilbao to their hotel. The Farewell dinner in the terrace of "Yandiola" finished the mobility in Spain.

During the 5<sup>th</sup> mobility the teachers agreed on the tasks to be done for the 6<sup>th</sup> exchange in Lithuania which will be held between 12<sup>th</sup> May 2020 (arrival) and 19<sup>th</sup> May 2020 (departure).

The delegations also agreed on the following:

- Each partner school will make the dissemination of the 5<sup>th</sup> project meeting and it is recommended to publish their results of work on their school web pages or school facebook pages, in the local media etc. and will send the outputs both to the coordinator and the other responsible teachers so that they could upload them into the project webpage, project facebook page, etwinning page etc.
- Each country will prepare some national dishes that will be presented at the National Cuisine Day in the school in Lithuania.
- Each country will prepare a short presentation of their country, town and school to be presented during the mobility in Lithuania. (5 min. maximum).
- Each country will prepare digital presentation about "Famous statesmen" and "Effective communication, European Citizenship".
- All the participants will watch the film "Three Idiots" before the mobility in Lithuania.
- Each country will bring some outdoor seeds / plants to help to organize the Project Garden in Lithuania.
- The Lithuanian team will prepare a survey on "Effective communication, European Citizenship" and will send it to the partner schools by 2<sup>nd</sup> March. Each school will then carry out the survey with 40 students and send the results to the host school by 16<sup>th</sup> March.
- All participating schools will send their newsletters by 14<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to the Turkish school. Maximum pages of each newsletter will be 4 pages per school. The participating schools should use word (Times New Roman-12) format and picasa for their photos and not more than 1 MB (1000 KB).
- The French school will keep maintaining the project eTwinning pages so that the visitors could see the results of our work. All partners will help to run this page.
- The participating schools are asked to send their name lists by March 30<sup>th</sup> (together with ages, genders and email addresses). Then, the Lithuanian school will send the other partners the programme of the 6<sup>th</sup> mobility.
- The accommodation details for students and teachers have to be sent by 21<sup>th</sup> of February.
- The Czech school will upload the results of the work (presentations, surveys etc.) on the website.
- The Italian school will organize the Europass and multilingual dictionary. Each partners should complete their part of multilingual dictionaries and upload on the etwinning platform until 29<sup>th</sup> February 2020. For the Europass, each partner school will fill in their Europasses on their own and bring to the 6<sup>th</sup> meeting in Lithuania so that the host school could sign them at the end of the project meeting.
- The Lithuanian school will maintain the Facebook page and hold Skype/eTwinning conference. The exact date for Skype/eTwinning conference was agreed to be at 16:00 pm CET on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2020.
- The Spanish school will work out the brochures, photo and video-presentation (a DVD; "Memorials of the project / Products exhibition" for each partner) from the meeting in the Spain to be presented at the meeting in Lithuania.
- The dates of the sixth meeting in Lithuania is 12<sup>th</sup> May 2020 (arrival) and 19<sup>th</sup> May 2020 (departure).

- All schools will continually carry on with local activities of the project according to the tasks.
- All schools will evaluate the budget of their schools and check the budget matters.
- None of the countries agree to accommodate the students in Lithuania in the dormitory without supervision of at least two adults on the same floor, one male and one female.
- The other issue is that under age students will be on their own after activities, which is not safe.

All the participants of the “Ants of Education” project appreciate the effort, the work and the warm hospitality of the Spanish organizers of the 5<sup>th</sup> mobility. All the participants find the activities very interesting and agree that they have learned a lot during the meeting. All the planned tasks and activities were fully accomplished.

The next meeting is going to be held in Lithuania between 12<sup>th</sup> May 2020 and 19<sup>th</sup> May 2020.






