Alex's point of view on the online Erasmus:



It was agreed who will be doing what:


- short video or ppt, Famous Statesmen" all partners.


The results of the survey "European Citizenship and Effective Communication" by host partner showed how students and teachers are feeling about being or not being part of European Union, how connected they are and connected to what city, country, Europe as region or European Union. Many interesting responds were provided

in open questions that included both parts of survey EU citizenship and effective communication.

27th of May 2020

The review of the movie "Three Idiots". Discussion and creating poster. Digital tools were used: Trello, Canva, Piktochart. The posters were created according the "life lessons" that were shown in the movie. 6 life lessons:

- 1. Phobia of new places and people.
- 2. Keep learning with new things.
- 3. Life is a race.
- 4. Excellence or success.
- 5. Avoid cramming.
- 6. Don't quit.



The workshop "EU Citizenship and Effective Communication" was provided by the external expert. The discussion used all time limits, active participation proved one more time how the topics about effective communication in education means so much, how the role of influencers shape the lives of young people, creates imagine even of such important areas as education, choosing profession or even "what's good and what's not". If there is no time limit, we could continue the discuss long long time but I have caught one insight firstly parents and then teachers should be those influencers at home, at school for every child, every student. Everybody knows it but so hard to follow it and make it work in real reality.

28th of May 2020

Project garden was prepared by florist teacher Kaunas Vocational School of Household Services and Business, that consists six different plants which represent different partner country. Of course, because of lockdown the plants were bought here in Lithuania.





3rd of June 2020

Coordinators meeting was dedicated for the review and feedback about the implemented online mobility. Discussion about the final report and final marks for to finalize dissemination part.

Despite some technical issues all tasks were done, all presentations were prepared and presented, seem we haven't lost anything but in fact we did.

We did lost the real meeting, we did lost travel forward and back, the energy and feeling being in crowded airports, we have lost meeting each other and shaking hands, kissing cheeks and hugging, we have lost to



taste one more time the national dishes from 6 different countries and finally we lost the mood of being all together. Does it seem like many loses? No, of course no. 
Wednesday 27: bye bye


We, the participating students shared the tasks and duties as soon as we were chosen.

Fatma Sıla YILMAZ got the responsibility of preparing the presentation"Famous Statesmen" and prepared a powerpoint presentation;




Barkın SABAH was responsible with the "Effective communication, European Citizenship" and the movie poster "Three Idiots"






Nisa Begüm ALADAĞ was responsible with preparing the workshop "National Cuisine"



Sude AKINCI worked on the Multilingual Dictionary and presentation of school and Antalya city.



The Lithuanian partner introduced their school, city and Lithuanian education system.




• results of survey on "Effective communication, European Citizenship" was presented. Following a workshop and seminer by an expert "Effective communication, European Citizenship" was given.




• All the partner schools presented their "Famous statesmen" workshops.

Monday, 25th May



We talked about different themes:


- the school systems

The second I was able to give my presentation on the French statesmen and the other participants gave theirs about the important men/women of their countries.


