



The 3rd mobility of the Erasmus+ project "Ants of Education" was held between 3rd and 8th May 2019 in Morlupo (Rome), Italy.

The organizer of the 3rd mobility was the Italian school "I.I.S. Margherita Hack".

The French delegation from "Lycee Maurice Genevoix", arrived on 2nd May and left on 9th May 2019. The delegation was composed of Ms Fatima Megdad and Ms Berengere Thuret de la Bouralière and the students Mr Ngom El Hadji Boubacar, Ms Konggapan Mantaree, Ms Lachaud Agathe and Mr Waty Saint-Martin Mika.

The Turkish delegation from "Özel Güney Fen Bilimleri Anadolu Lisesi" arrived on 2nd May and left on 9th May 2019. The delegation was composed of Ms Ummahan Çoban Yüceyaltirik, Mr Tuncay Savtak and Ms Melahat Karaahmetoğlu Orak and the students Mr Ali Mert Erdoğan, Ms Aybike Vreskala, and Mr Buğra Aydemir.

The Czech delegation from "Střední odborná škola ochrany osob a majetku, s.r.o" arrived on 2nd May and left on 9th May 2019. The delegation was composed of Ms Pavla Kubíčková, Mr Emil Horký and Martin Feranc and the students Ms Veronika Menaříková, Mr Ondřej Štefánik and Ms Nela Doláková.

The Spanish delegation from “Centro San Viator”, arrived on 2nd May and left on 9th May 2019. The delegation was composed of Ms Ane Ruiloba Pérez and Ms Amaya Carrero Vilaboa and the students Mr Berly Matansio Kimvumu, Mr Iker De La Cuesta Velasquez and Mr Juan Daniel Portillo.

The Lithuanian delegation from “Kauno buitinių paslaugų ir verslo mokykla”, arrived on 2nd May and left on 9th May 2019. The delegation was composed of Ms Dalia Vasiliauskienė and Ms Vaiva Daugvilaitė and the students Ms Laura Bagdzevičiūtė, Ms Orinta Vaitkevičiūtė and Ms Saulė Rudzinskaitė.

On **Thursday 2nd May 2019** all the participants were welcomed by the host teachers at the hotel and at the airport. All the teams came by bus to the hotel that had been booked, where the host families collected their guest pupils. Lithuanian students had to stay in the hotel for the first night as they arrived after midnight.

On **Friday 3rd May 2019**, all the participants arrived at school and were welcomed by the headmistress and where the partner schools presented their countries, towns and schools. Then, all the participants together with the headmistress were taken by bus to Palazzetto in Morlupo to meet the Mayor. Inside the building the ceremony was held. During the ceremony the project “Ants of Education” and Erasmus plus programme were introduced by the project coordinator. The ceremony continued with a guided tour of the historical centre of the town and a buffet offered by the local council at Palazzetto Borghese. After the buffet all the participants moved to I.I.S. Margherita Hack where the “Project Garden” was organized in the school garden. Right after the “Project Garden”, within the frame of “the protection of the environment”, the participants went to the “Park of Veio” for a guided hike of the park. The participants were led through the park by a botanist, a biologist, the Mayor of Morlupo and two rangers. In the evening a “Welcome Dinner” was held for the teachers and the students spent their evening with their host families.

On **Saturday 4th May 2019** a trip by bus to the large archeological site of “Ostia Antica” showed the participants Rome’s main seaport during the Roman Republic, despite the rainy day. After visiting the remains, all the group was taken to Piazza San Pietro to visit the Basilica and the surrounding area. All the participants went back home to Morlupo by bus.

On **Sunday 5th May 2019** all the participants gathered at the train station to go by train to visit Rome. The tour started from Piazzale Flaminio and on foot, in spite of the rainy and windy day, the main sights were visited: Piazza del Popolo, the church of Santa Maria del Popolo, the Pincio, the Spanish square, Piazza Navona, the Pantheon, the Aqua Virgo Aqueduct, Trevi Fountain, Quirinale and the Colosseum.

On **Monday 6th May** the Italian school system was presented by a student and the discussion and activities based on the film “Like stars on earth” were organized. The pupils were divided into mixed nationality groups. After watching some sections of the film they were involved in activities and discussions related to the film. After the usual break at 10.50, a tour at school led the students to the physics laboratory where some Italian students showed some of the experiments that they carry out in the lab. The day went on with the organization of the “National Cuisine Day” which, as the school does not have a canteen, took place in an adjacent restaurant. During this event all the participants had an opportunity to taste the partners’ typical dishes served in their countries. After

that, the group went to Mount Soratte for a guided tour of the mysterious Nazi bunker. They went back home at 6.00 pm.

On **Tuesday 7th May** the participants went by bus to CNR (National Research Council) located in Montelibretti to meet some experts on "Natural Disasters" with whom the Italian students had met a few times to study the volcanic, seismic and fire risks as part of a work-related learning project. The presentation of the results of the survey on "Natural disasters and protecting the environment" was introduced to all participants by an Italian student and all the Italian students in groups presented the different risks and real situations. The group went back to school at 2 p.m. and the afternoon was free to spend with host families.

On **Wednesday 8th May** a workshop on the protection of the environment was held in the school library by the Director general of the department of Civil protection. Next, all the partner schools presented the children's festivals, focusing particularly on young people and celebrations in each country, region or town. After the break, the Multilingual Dictionary was organized in the school library. During the workshop the pupils worked together on the specific topics to complement the work which had been started and continued on the first and second meeting. The students went home at the end of the school classes to get ready for the "Farewell Dinner". After lunch, the teachers met to discuss the dissemination of the project meeting, evaluation/progress check and Europass mobility in the school. The teachers agreed on the planned activities and tasks to be done and the methods to be used between the meetings.

At 6 p.m. the participants gathered in Castelnuovo di Porto for a guided tour of the duke's palace "Rocca Colonna" and of the historical centre. Once back in the palace, before the Farewell Dinner, some young musicians, from a music school located in Castelnuovo, sang several songs and played the instruments to make the participants enjoy their last evening in Italy. After dinner all the participants were given their certificates of attendance and the third mobility was officially completed.

On **Thursday 9th May**, the departure day, the Czech, the Spanish, the Turkish and the Lithuanian were transferred to the airport by bus, and the French Team to Morlupo railway station.

During the third mobility the teachers agreed on the tasks to be done for the 4th exchange in France which will be held between 11th December (arrival) and 18th December (departure).

The delegations also agreed on the following:

- Each partner school will make the dissemination of the 3rd project meeting and it is recommended to publish their results of work on their school web pages, in the local media etc. and will send the outputs both to the coordinator and the other responsible teachers so that they could upload them into project webpage, project facebook page, etwinning page etc.

- Each country will prepare some national dishes that will be presented at the National Cuisine Day in the school of France.
- Each country will prepare a short presentation of their country, town and school to be presented during the mobility in France (5 minutes maximum).
- Each country will bring some seeds/plants to help to organize the Project Garden in France.
- The French team will prepare a survey on “ESL, violence and bullying, lack of literacy” and will send it to the partner schools by the end of September 2019. Each school will then carry out the survey with 30-50 students and send the results to the host school by 15 October 2019.
- The Italian school will prepare an evaluation form and send it to the Czech school by 27 May 2019. The Czech school will publish the results of the evaluation form by 20 June 2019 on the Project Website (etwinning, blog, Facebook).
- All participating schools will send their newsletters by 27 May 2019 to the Turkish school. Maximum pages of each newsletter will be 4 pages per school. The participating schools should use word (Times New Roman -12) format and jpg/png format for their photos. The newsletter should not exceed 1 MB. The newsletter should consist of 3 parts – preparation for the mobility, progress during the mobility, and the dissemination of the mobility at home.
- All partners are obliged to upload their photos to Google drive so that they can be shared and used by all the partners.
- The French school will keep maintaining the project eTwinning pages so that the visitors could see the results of our work. All partners will help to run this page.
- The participating schools are asked to send their name lists as soon as they know the names of participants (together with ages, genders and email addresses). Then, the French school will send the other partners the programme of the 4th mobility and the host families’ contacts by 1 November 2019.
- The Czech school will upload the results of the work (presentations, surveys etc.) on the Project Website.
- The Italian school will organize the Europass and multilingual dictionary. For the Europass, each partner school will fill their Europasses on their own and bring to the 4th meeting in France so that the host school could sign them at the end of the project meeting.
- The Lithuanian school will maintain the Facebook page and hold Skype/eTwinning conference, the exact date will be agreed by the school coordinators through email communication.

- The Spanish school will work out the brochures, photo and video-presentation (a DVD; "Memorials of the project/Products exhibition" for each partners) from the meeting in Italy to be presented at the meeting in France.
- Meetings in France, Spain and Lithuania will take time: France 11 (arrival day) – 18 (departure day) December 2019, Spain 6 (arrival day) – 13 (departure day) February 2020, Lithuania 12 (arrival day) – 19 (departure day) May 2020.
- All school will continually carry on with local activities of the project according to the tasks.
- All schools will evaluate the budget of the 1st year of the project in their schools and check the budget matters.
- All the partners are obliged to write their part of the mid-term report and send it to the coordinator by 31 May 2019.


